## **HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT REPORT:**

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss a safe way to get the highway workers back to work, they have been off since the beginning of the March and we are beginning to get backed up on work.

Chuck feels that we could get 2 guys to come in on Monday & Tuesdays and work their normal 10 hour days, Wednesday's there would be no crew here and the garage would sit dormant, then the other 2 guys would come in Thursday & Friday's for their 10 hour shift.

This would be in keeping with social distancing. They would be required to work independently and only 1 guy per truck. At the end of each shift they will be required to sanitize the trucks and shop area for the next crew to work safely reducing the exposure.

Jerri is concerned that the highway guys could be carriers and give to each other. Betty states feels that anyone could be a carrier and not even have symptoms.

Bill Thomas just wants to be sure that the guys are safe and they know the precautions that they need to take, Chuck will be informing them of the procedures to follow.

It is decided that they will return to work on April 13 with the schedule that was discussed. This will be re-evaluated on the next call that is scheduled for April 20 at 7 PM.
